

Role Definition

Job Title: Industrial Designer - Student Intern
Reporting to: Industrial Designer on a day to day basis and ultimately to the Head of Industrial Design

Responsibilities

- To assist the Industrial Designers working on industrial and furniture projects within the department
- To assist the Industrial Designers prepare and develop from the brief, a design proposal and presentation by means of hand sketches, technical drawings, graphics, CAD models, working and presentation models
- To give support where needed to colleagues within the industrial team
- To comply with Foster + Partners procedures and standards
- To contribute, or otherwise assist as required

Essential qualities and skills required

- Able to demonstrate ability to undertake the above responsibilities
- Legally able to work in the country in which the position is based
- Able to construct sketch and high-level presentation models in house for review
- Excellent organisational skills
- Able to manage sensitive and sometimes confidential information
- Self motivated and able to take responsibility
- Able to prioritise tasks and time efficiently
- Able to demonstrate initiative and a proactive approach to tasks
- Good interpersonal skills and able to work as part of an effective team
- Flexible attitude
- Able to build good relationships at all levels

This description reflects the core activities of the role but is not intended to be all-inclusive and other duties within the group/department may be required in addition to changes in the emphasis of duties as required from time to time. There is a requirement for the post holder to recognise this and adopt a flexible approach to work.
